ARTICLE II OFFICE

The principal office of the Corporation shall be established and located in 2544 Taft Avenue, City of Manila, Philippines.

ARTICLE III MEMBERSHIP

Section 1. Admission and Qualifications. The members of the Corporation shall consist of the incorporators named in the Articles of Incorporation and such other members as may be admitted from time to time by the affirmative vote of the majority of the Board of the corporation. In considering the qualifications of prospective members,

the following factors, among others, shall be considered: (a) good moral character, (b) high scholastic standing or academic proficiency, (c) completion of university studies and/or acquisition of specialized skills or training in the fields of education, literature, philosophy, the sciences and the arts, (d) distinction in professional, business or other vocation and (e) genuine interest and involvement in affairs of the Corporation.

Loss of Membership in the Corporation shall be generally lost by any of the following reasons: death, resignation, incapacity to act, or expulsion upon the vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the entire membership of the Corporation. In the case of a member of the Corporation who is also a member of the De La Salle Brothers, his resignation, removal, or loss of membership from De La Salle Brothers in accordance with the rules and constitution thereof shall result in the automatic loss of membership in the Corporation. A Member who is nominated or designated by the Lasallian East Asia District Brother Visitor or Auxilliary Visitor of De La Salle Brothers shall automatically lose his membership in the Corporation after he shall have served the Term Limitation defined in Article V, Section 2. An Individual Member whose assignment by the Lasallian East Asia District Brother Visitor or the Auxiliary Visitor of the De La Salle Brothers may conflict or interfere with his duties as a member of the corporation as determined or advised by the La Sallian East Asia District Brother Visitor of the Ausiliary Visitor of De La Salle Brothers to the Board of Trustees of the Corporation shall result in the automatic loss of his membership in the Corporation. An Individual Member shall also automatically lose his membership in the Corporation if he is no longer engaged in the administration and management of the Corporation or performs any administrative or management function as may be determined by the President. However, said member may later on still be readmitted as a member of the Corporation and elected as a member of the Board of Trustees. (Amended as of 13 January 2020)

Section 3. Ratio of membership. At no time shall the membership of Filipino citizens be less than the required minimum percentage, as provided by existing laws of the total general membership. At least 51% of the members of the Corporation shall be members of the Philippine Sector of the De La Salle Brothers or individuals nominated or designated by members of the Philippine Sector of the De La Salle Brothers.
