RE: **DLSP Participation: Follow-up Activities for the Trillion Peso Movement Against Corruption**

Dear **Lasallian Partners**,

Last September 21, 2025, our Lasallian network participated in the *Trillion Peso March Against Corruption*, joining the growing public outcry over what is now considered one of the worst corruption scandals in our country's history. The Filipino people remain justifiably outraged—and as a Lasallian community committed to faith, service, and communion in mission, we must continue to call for transparency, accountability, and decisive action from our public officials.

To sustain our participation in the *Trillion Peso Movement Against Corruption*, we encourage the school communities to consider organizing or participating in the following initiatives:

1. **Support the CBCP's Call** – Tie white ribbons on school fences and encourage families to do the same in their homes as a sign of solidarity.
2. **Designate a "White Shirt Day"** – Wear white shirts on an agreed day of the week to symbolize unity in the call against corruption. The school may consider Friday as suggested by CBCP.
3. **Organize Anti-Corruption Fora** – Hold sessions with parents, students, faculty, staff, alumni, and community partners to deepen understanding and encourage action.

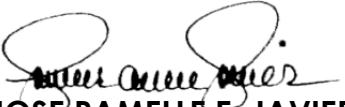
4. **Host Roundtable Discussions** – Focus on the national budgeting process and encourage citizen involvement through participatory audits.
5. **Monitor Local Infrastructure Projects** – Take part in tracking flood control and other local infrastructure initiatives. Schools may coordinate with their local dioceses. Engagement can include:
 - o Research and documentation
 - o Service-learning projects
 - o Resource mobilization
 - o Volunteering with platforms such as Rappler's civic engagement initiatives (ie. [FloodControlPH](https://www.rappler.com/philippines/n30235369-flood-control/): <https://www.rappler.com/philippines/n30235369-flood-control/>)
6. **Support Youth Leadership Development** – Partner with DLSP in the development of a leadership and accompaniment program for Lasallian Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) leaders.
7. **Join the Next National Mobilization** – We invite everyone to participate in the upcoming *Trillion Peso Movement Against Corruption* on **November 30, 2025 (Sunday) at 10:00 AM** at the **People Power Monument**.

For schools in **Luzon**, we will gather at **La Salle Green Hills (LSGH)** at **8:00 AM** for a short prayer service before marching together to the People Power Monument at **8:45 AM**. For schools in the **Visayas and Mindanao**, we encourage participation in local mobilizations in coordination with anti-corruption groups in your area.

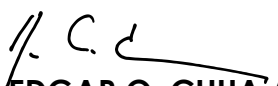
